Tightening COVID- 19 restrictions

The Cabinet of Ministers approved Decree # 220 dated 25 June 2020 on further measures on preventing spread of COVID-19 in the territory of Azerbaijan. As per Decree residents of Baku, Sumgayit, Ganja, Lankaran, Yevlakh, Masalli, Jalilabad and Absheron district may leave home still sending SMS to 8103 or using “e-Tabib” mobile app.

Also as per Decree only 50 percent of employees are allowed to work in the following areas:

- 4.4. Production of daily care and hygiene products;
- 4.11. Production and repair of construction and household equipment;
- 4.12. Engineering and design services;
- 4.14. Production of packaging products;
- 4.15. Production of stone, metal and wood products;
- 4.16. Furniture production and repair;
- 5.4. Zoo shops, including animal feed sales points;
- 5.5. Points of sale of construction materials and household items;
- 5.6. Online sales;
- 6.2. Dry cleaning;
- 6.3. Cleaning of residential buildings, except for apartments;
- 6.4. Car repairs;
- 6.5. Car wash points;
- 6.6. Animal shelters;
- 9.2. Translation services.

Number of permits issued to service contractors in the above areas shall not exceed 30% of the total number of contracted employees allowed to work.
