Further easing of Special Quarantine Regime in Azerbaijan

The Azerbaijan Cabinet of Ministers has adopted Decree on 01 May 2020 that Special Quarantine regime in country extended till 31 May 2020. At the same time as per Decree starting from 04th of May:

1. All authorities in Baku, Sumgait, Ganja, Lankaran and Absheron district will resume work (maximum number of employees will be determined with another Decree of Cabinet of Ministers)
2. Social Services Centers "DOST" will resume normal work
3. Activities restricted due to COVID-19 pandemic will be allowed to work
4. All type of shops, barber shops, beauty and makeup shops will re-open

All restrictions including obtaining permits at icaze.e-gov.az and thru SMS system will be cancelled in all districts of Azerbaijan except Baku, Sumgait, Ganja, Lankaran and Absheron district.

It is still prohibited for people to gather in groups more than 10 people in public places, on boulevards and parks, as well as in public catering facilities throughout the country.

Schools and educational institutions will be closed till 31 May 2020.

Those living in Baku, Sumgait, Ganja, Lankaran and Absheron district will still need to use permits using portal icaze.e-gov.az.
